Cong. Mack Receives ASCF “Eagle of Freedom” Award

On March 10, 2011 Congressman Connie Mark (R) FI-14 received the American Security Council Foundations “Eagle of Freedom Award” for his strong support of a safe and prosperous Western Hemisphere.

In presenting the award, Brigadier General Donald Smith, who is chairman of the American Security Council Foundation’s Board of Directors, said, “In recognition for his leadership, courage and vision in revitalizing the Western Hemisphere and America’s defense capabilities, Congressman Mack’s tremendous dedication and distinguished service has resulted in numerous strides to increase the readiness of America’s Armed Forces and the advancement of peace, democracy and human rights.”
